14.00-15.15 hrs	<b>Part I: Clean Energy and Climate Action – 6 Times Faster, 6 Times Bigger?</b> The rising demand for energy brings along with it not only a dire need for higher supply of energy but also of cleaner, reliable and affordable energy sources. According to a recently published International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA) Report, renewable energy and energy efficiency can, in combination, provide over 90% of the necessary energy-related CO2

The report further states that renewable energy needs <u>to be scaled up at least six times faster</u> for the world to meet the decarbonisation and climate mitigation goals set out in the Paris Agreement. India's renewable energy targets of 175 GW by 2022, coupled with its NDC targets of 40% non-fossil-based power capacity by 2030 make the focus on cleaner sources of energy quite evident.</p> <p><i>This first part of the session will focus on various RE options, their resource efficiency, and their role in providing affordable and clean energy to the masses.</i></p>
